Project successfully completed in the financial year 2019-20

1) Where the Rain Falls (WtRF) (supported by CARE INDIA)

The aim of the project is to Reduce input cost in cotton Production. Climate Change Adaptation and Cotton Production (CCACP) project base on organic cotton Production. have improved livelihood and food security. The project area is 10 villages in Jalgaon (ja) block, Buldana district, Maharashtra.

Works done under this project

1. Formation of village développement committee in 10 villages.
2. Formation of Social Monitoring Committee in 10 villages.
3. Soil and water conservation work done in 3 village (Rehabilitation of Mati Nala Bandh, pond)
4. Facilitate Bi-monthly VDC-led briefing sessions in project villages street play
5. Implement Village Disaster Resilience Plans
6. Awareness MGNREGA Programme conducting 10 project village (street play program)
7. preparation of Community Action Plan with PRA members in 10 village
8. Block level Workshop done for Climate Change adaptation (PRI & line department) 79 participant attend this workshop
9. 4 Gram panchayat level Workshop done for Community Action Plan with VDC & PRA members.
106 participant attend this workshop
10. 10 village covered under integrating CAPs in local Development
11. Health camps were conducted at panchayat level in which health check up of 141 beneficiaries done



2) Climate Change Adaptation and Cotton Production (CCACP) project (supported by CARE INDIA)

The aim of the project is to Reduce input cost in cotton Production. Climate Change Adaptation and Cotton Production (CCACP) project based on organic cotton Production have improved livelihood and food security. The project area is 10 villages in Jalgaon (ja) block, Buldana district, Maharashtra.

Works done under this project

- ② 111 farmers was selected for démonstration plot in 10 Project village
- ② first year, Promotion of organic cotton cultivation in 55 demonstration plots (0.5 acres each) with 55 lead farmers from the 5 project villages.
- ② Conducting village level training on organic cotton cultivation and Package of Practices followed at each stage of organic cotton production.
- ② Formation of a Block Level Organic Cotton Committee (BLOCC) to advocate on organic cotton Display of Information Education Communication (IEC) material on organic cotton cultivation.
- ② All the 55 demo plot farmers provided required inputs and technical support for organic cotton cultivation by the project during this cropping season.(seed, fertiliser)
- ② 387 tribal farmers (207 male and 180 female) participated in Lead farmers' training.(Soil testing, seed traitement, compost, botanical extract.)
- ② 51 Self Help Group Formation in this project. Total 551 Members
- ② 2 SHGs started the cotton storage bags and Tailoring business under this project.
- ② 244 women participated in 48 SHGs completing training on Financial literacy.
- ② 245 women Leaders participated in 46 SHGs completing training on Leadership training
- ② 408 women Leaders participated in 48 SHGs completing training on capacity building training programs
- ② The Experience Sharing program was conducted in 5 villages on Organic cotton production .
- ② 5 Farmer Groups Formation on this project. Total 50 Members
- ② Organic cotton production village level awareness campaign program conducted in 5 villages Through the projector .
- ② 530 participants (41 men, 51 women and 477 children) participated in the awareness sessions for parents, teachers, school-going children and youth on Child Labour issues.
- ② Soil and water conservation work was done in 6 villages (CNB rehabilitate, Well Contraction, pond)
- ② awareness about child labor, for Children's Day program was celebrated in 7 villages, with 237 Parents participants.
- ② Organize exposure visits for tribal women smallholders to cotton processors (ginning and spinning units) Program done. 75 participants attend this program



3) Maharashtra flood response and Early recovery project (Supported by CARE India)

The aim of the project is relief to flood affected communities from the Kolhapur and Sangli districts of flood prone regions of Maharashtra have improved food security and better health conditions for early recovery.

The project area is 15 villages in Shirol block, Kolhapur district and 5 villages in Palus Block, Sangli District from Maharashtra.

Works done under this project

- Provide 6500 man days work in 11 villages.
- Distribution of 2075 dry ration kits in 11 villages.
- Awareness camp on WASH issues in 20 villages.
- Distribution of seeds kit to 200 farmers in 10 villages.
- Distribution of 150 hygiene kits.



4) DPR preparation for Integrated Watershed Development for 05 villages from Jamkhed Block of Ahmednagar District, Maharashtra(Supported by Bajaj CSR)

MPSSM submitted a project proposal for water conservation work in the jamkhed block. The Bajaj CSR approved proposal and DPR preparation work

The Proposed villages are Naygaon, Dhamangaon, Devdahithan, Bandth Khadak and Nahuli in jamkhed block various activities were undertaken while preparing DPR.

Mainly the activity were

- 1) Baseline Survey
- 2) PRA
- 3) Net Planning
- 4) Well Inventory
- 5) Collection of primary and secondary data

- 6) L section survey
- 7) Preparation of Estimate
- 8) Geological survey
- 9) Treatment map
- 10) Preparation of Agriculture and livelihood plan

Innovative agriculture and livelihood plans proposed in DPR and simultaneously various SMC works were proposed. All village communities actively participated in DPR preparation.



5) Providing quality education for children from NT/DNT communities, supported by Karuna Trust. (Yashodhara hostel project)

The aim of the project is to ensure that Paradhi children live in a supportive environment so that they can attend school successfully and on a regular basis. In this project 64 students are living in these hostels and learning regularly, also they are having nutritious food. The location of the hostel is Village Dagadi Baradgaon(RASHIN), karjat block, Ahmednagar district, Maharashtra. The Government school was also established in 2017 in a nearby hostel. The change in their nature and their health could be noticed.



6) Distribution of Material to Tiwre Dam (Chiplun District Ratnagiri) affected families

A big dam namely TIWARE DAM in chiplun block of ratnagiri district (konkan region) crashed and forced water had damaged /affected downstream seven villages. In which 18 families from village bend wadi are washed and 24 people are missing and many people are injured .

This background ,MPSSM provided 39 beds and mattresses to the affected families. SEEDS INDIA also provided some support for this work.
